PROGRAM-SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

- Letters of Recommendation (3)
- CV/Resume

- Writing Sample of at least 10-30 pages. This can be previous individual academic or professional work. It does not necessarily have to be related to architecture and historic preservation, however a related topic is preferred. The writing sample should

demonstrate the ability to analyze a problem/question and clearly communicate your findings. Upload to the *Writing Sample* of the *Uploads Requirements* section of the online application.

- Must be admitted by both programs to pursue dual degree
