POPULATION STUDIES, POST-BACCALAUREATE CERTIFICATE (P.B.C.)

12 credits required

The Certificate requires a minimum of four courses (12 credits) including two required core courses and two electives. At least one course taken for the Certificate must be from a department other than the student's home unit. (See the Certificate information page on the MPRC website (http://www.popcenter.umd.edu/resources/scholar-dev/demographycert/certificate/) for details.) Students must achieve a GPA of 3.0 or higher in these four courses. Previously earned credits may be retroactively applied toward the Certificate.
